## LCP REPRESENTS WELL AT PANHANDLE

LCP sent six wrestlers to the Panhandle Nationals this weekend in Lubbock. John Geiger, Curtis Harrison, Lance Reed, Kyle Tibbetts, Thomas Tolbert, and Tyler Young made the six and a half hour trek to Lubbock with other Central Region wrestlers aboard a chartered bus. Wrestlers competed against kids from New Mexico, Oklahoma, and Colorado.

Although LCP placed four wrestlers in the top six of their Division the highlight was Tyler Young taking home the D4 Heavyweight Championship belt and Kyle Tibbetts

taking sixth place in the D2 61 lbs Division as a Novice.

Other placers included John Geiger capturing 4th Place in the D3 65 lbs division and Curtis Harrison taking 6th Place in the D4 85 lbs.

Special recognition should also go out to Tyler Young who assisted in cornering Kyle Tibbetts and discussing post match strategy. Great effort from all of the LCP wrestlers in Lubbock.
